

## ON-SITE ATTENDANCE POLICY

*Effective 3/3/22*

- We request that only those fully vaccinated attend our services and programs.
- Those who are not fully vaccinated will be permitted to attend but are required to wear a mask, preferably a KN-95 or similar. Wearing a mask is optional for vaccinated visitors.
- We encourage social distancing at your own comfort level.
- If you have experienced any flu-like symptoms within 7 days prior to attendance or if you have been in contact with anyone diagnosed with COVID-19 in this timeframe, we urge you to stay home.
- Please practice safe food handling techniques whenever food is available (e.g. using tongs or other utensils).

There is always a risk of exposure to COVID-19 in any public place where people are present. While Temple Israel cannot eliminate all risk, we attempt to reduce risk for our guests by requesting everyone follow our attendance policy which includes vaccination status, social distancing, voluntary mask-wearing and using hand sanitizer. However, the success of our policy is predicated on everyone voluntarily following these important safety practices, including staying home when you don't feel well!
